## What does ServierONE offer?

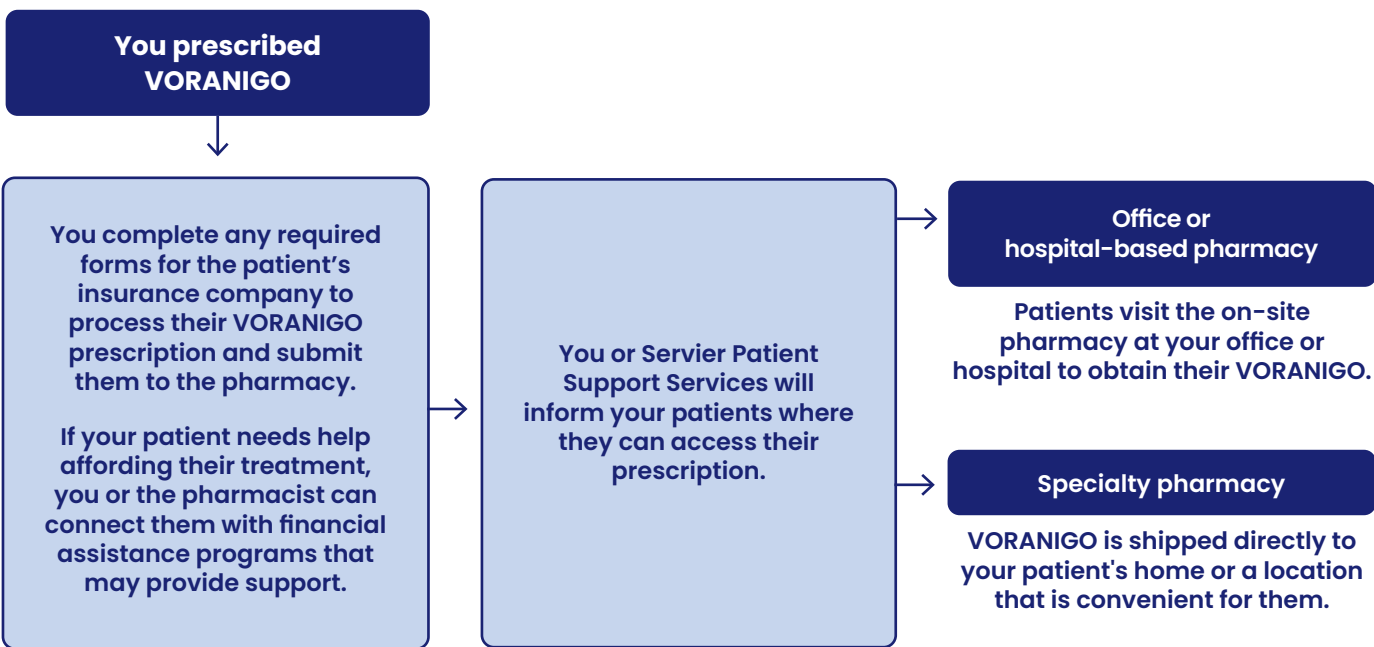
We work with you to ensure your patients have the support they need, when they need it.

# Patient & Support Services

## Guidance every step of the way

Our Patient Support Programs offer dedicated resources to guide you and your patients through the entire treatment journey.

- **Patient Reimbursement Manager (PRM):** Available for virtual consultations, our PRM can meet with you and your office to provide an overview of our Patient Support Programs and answer any questions you may have.
- **Nurse Navigator:** From the start of treatment, our Nurse Navigator is there for your patients, offering personalized support and periodic check-ins to ensure they feel confident and supported throughout their journey.

## VORANIGO (vorasidenib) Financial & Personal Support Programs

- **\$0 Copay Program\***  
The \$0 Copay Program lowers the out-of-pocket cost of VORANIGO for eligible patients with commercial insurance to as little as \$0 per prescription if the copay exceeds that amount.
- **Bridge Program†**  
The Bridge Program is designed to provide a one-time, 1-month supply of VORANIGO to qualified patients who experience a short-term lapse in coverage. This program gives patients access to VORANIGO while insurance issues are being resolved.
- **QuickStart Program†**  
The QuickStart Program is intended for patients who experience an insurance coverage delay lasting five or more business days. Eligible patients will receive one, 30-day supply as prescribed by their healthcare provider. If there is a further delay in coverage, patients are eligible to receive another 30-day supply refill per Servier approval.
- **Patient Assistance Program (PAP)‡**  
PAP is dedicated to assisting uninsured and underinsured patients by offering medication to those who meet our eligibility criteria. This program is designed to ensure that financial constraints do not hinder access to necessary treatments.

\*This program is available to eligible patients who meet the following criteria: U.S./Puerto Rico resident, commercially insured and paying a portion of their cost, and don't have government insurance.  
†Patients may be eligible for the Bridge Program or QuickStart Program if they meet the following criteria: U.S./Puerto Rico resident, commercially insured, and have completed the enrollment form.  
‡Patients may be eligible for PAP if they meet the following criteria: U.S./Puerto Rico resident, commercially, privately, or government insured, and have completed the enrollment form. Financial qualification: household annual gross income does not exceed 600% of the U.S. Federal Poverty Level. If your patient doesn't meet these criteria, other forms of assistance may be available.
